

SURVIVAL IN THE FOREST

If the car does not start and you're stuck in the woods, and you have no solution to continue your road, I'm going to teach you how to make shelter and to provide electricity from your car.



First search in the trunk for any tools that can help you build your shelter.



In my case I have an ax, a wrench, a jack, a big and a small knife, a headlamp bulb and a bottle with car oil.



First I will need the two lights from the trunk, so to remove them I must first remove the protective mask and cut the wires where it' connected.





After I have taken the lights, I must remove the battery. First I need to remove the protection system then disconnect it from all threads with a patent.





After I got the battery out from the car I'm going to connect the lights from the trunk. I'm going to clean the wires then I'm going to connect the plus to plus, and the minus to minus.



As you can see we have power, it is working. You can also charge the phone battery with it.



I'm changing the light from the trunk with the headlamp bulb because it is much lighter, and it is working.



Now let's start making the shelter. First look for a spot to build your shelter, as you can see I have found two parallel trees and a little inclined. Behind the trees are bushes which will make the back of the shelter. After that, scatter around for thick branches to make the base of the shelter. Cut the thin branches from the thick one with an ax. Keep the thin branches as we will use them to keep the fire. You can also leave some thin branches on the thick ones.





Now I will start the fire, I put a little bit of oil on a page from a book, and then use the headlamp bulb to light the page. A little amount of smoke comes out.



And it started. The smoke which comes from the fire will keep the bugs out from you.



To save power on the battery, cut the light of and use the light from the fire to continue to build the shelter.

After I heaved made the base for the shelter, I'm going to attach the thin branches on horizontal position until I will make a layer from them.



To make more smoke to keep the bugs out of the way you can also put on fire some green leaves.

After I heaved made the layer from thin branches I will make another layer from branches with green leaves. You can also put some dry leaves. The second layer will keep the water if it will rain from entering the shelter.

This one which I heaved made is for one person. It is a base introduction on how to make, but you can make for two or more persons, just look for longer branches.
